

The Report to the APCM on Goods and Ornaments for the year 2020-2021.

During the last twelve months there has been only one acquisition & no disposals. A Communion Table has been purchased for use in the main body of the Church for under £200- & a licence for its use obtained which expires on August 2022. This will enhance the safety of Communion services as people attending will be able to be suitably socially distanced until the summer of next year. After that, the Table may be upcycled.

The Arts Society have almost completed the Church Records Project which will enable a Terrier for future generations to be completed & the Church become compliant. Although this was halted by lockdown the project should be completed by the summer.

We were hoping to arrange for a new set of photographs of our silver to be completed as the ones done at the turn of the decade were accidentally disposed of during the clearing of the flat of a former Churchwarden by his solicitors. Although we have now discovered a second copy, this has only highlighted the need for an upgraded version which would also satisfy our Insurers.
